The ELRC evaluates the Indy STEM Teacher
Residency Program, a collaborative effort between
Indianapolis Public Schools (IPS) and Purdue
University, with the aim of preparing culturally
competent and highly qualified career teachers
who can elevate student achievement in STEM
subjects, including computer science, in IPS's
middle and high schools.

### The Context

- Over 27% teacher turnover per year
- High need district that serves a diverse population (racially, ethnically & socioeconomically)
- **❖** Largest urban school district in Indiana
- **❖**65% of student population qualify for free or reduced lunch







- Beyond process & impact measures, we account for contextual factors



- **❖** Foster a culture of continuous improvement with actionable recommendations.
